## What Are Values and Why They Matter?

**Values are the guiding principles that can help shape how your group functions** - how members act, make decisions, and interact with one another. They help define the culture you want to create together and ensure that everyone is aligned in how the group operates.

Clear, shared values foster trust, belonging, and consistency. They can also serve as a helpful reference point when navigating challenges or resolving conflicts, offering a grounded way to return to what matters most.

In short, values are the “why” behind everything your group does. By identifying them early, you help ensure that your actions, communication, and goals stay true to the purpose you’re building together.

## Step 1: Define Your Group's Mission

Your mission is the foundation of your group. It should describe the purpose, direction, and impact you hope to create.

### **Prompts:**

What is the core purpose of your group?

Whom do you serve or hope will gather?

What change or outcome do you hope to support?

*Example: “Our group provides a supportive space for people to connect, learn, and grow. We bring individuals with shared interests together and offer resources and discussions that inspire positive change.”*

## **Step 2: Identify Your Main Objectives**

Objectives are the concrete outcomes or priorities that help fulfill your mission.

### **Prompts:**

What change do you want to see in individuals, communities, or systems?

What do you want members to feel or experience when they participate?

*Example: "Our objectives are to help members build confidence, deepen their knowledge, and feel supported within a strong community. We aim to create meaningful experiences that encourage growth, connection, and positive change."*

## **Step 3: List Key Behaviors That Support Your Objectives**

Key behaviors are visible actions that reinforce your mission and create your group culture.

### **Prompts:**

*Examples: Act in a kind respectful manner. Be patient when others are learning.*
